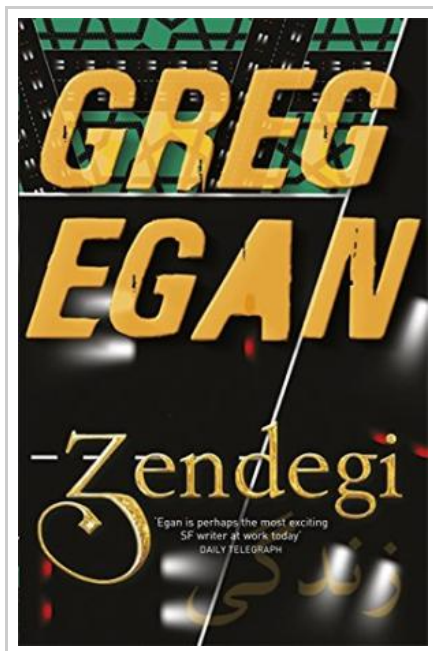




Zendegi (Paperback)

But Zendegi is about to become a battlefield .



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
