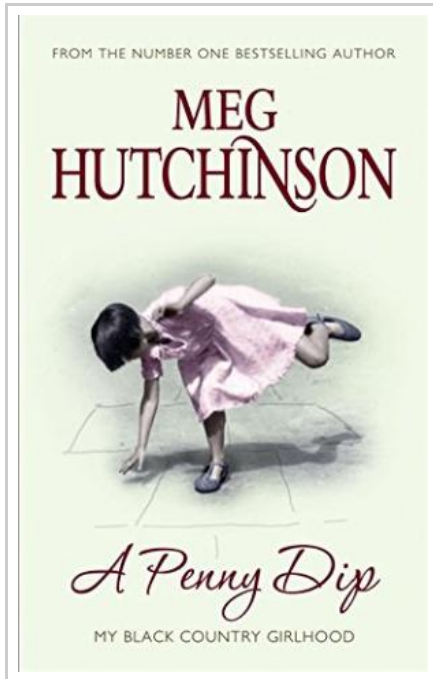




A Penny Dip: My Black Country Girlhood
