Next, we estimated the model using CPS supplement data for 2001 and 2004 sequentially. Table 8 presents the marginal effects and standard errors from these estimations. Holding all else equal, overall results from both data sets indicate that highly-educated employees are much more likely to bring work home than less-educated employees, black employees are less likely to bring work home than white employees, and Hispanic employees are less likely to bring work home than non-Hispanic employees. We also find that females are less likely to bring work home than males, except in the 2001 CPS Supplement; although, the magnitude of these gender effects is small compared with the magnitude of the education effects. It is also possible that these gender differences may actually capture occupation and industry differences in jobs held by gender that are not specified in our model.
