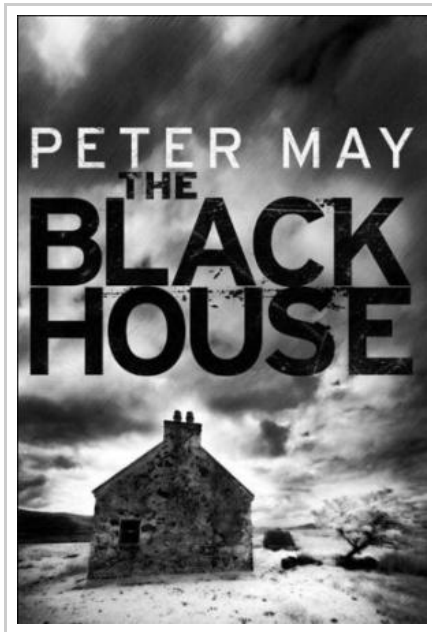




The Blackhouse

Winning numerous awards internationally particularly in his adopted home of France May's haunting trilogy follows Edinburgh detective inspector Fin Macleod as he is drawn back to his boyhood home on the Isle of Lewis. The starkly beautiful landscape of the Outer Hebrides becomes almost a character itself in this series, rendered in unforgettable detail by the Scottish-born author, creator of the Enzo Files and China Thrillers series as well...
