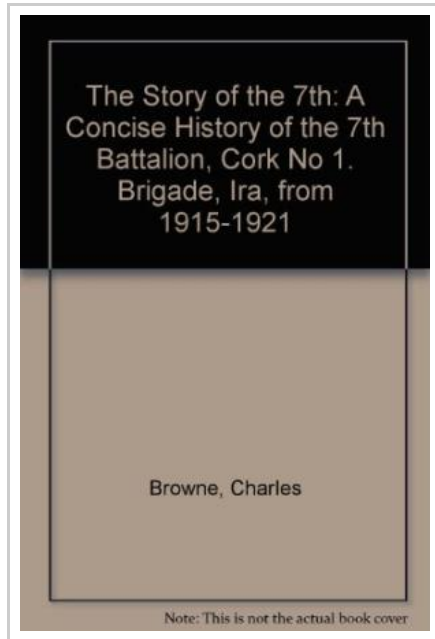




The Story of the 7th

A concise history of the 7th Battalion, Cork No 1 Brigade, IRA, from 1915 to 1921. Browne, the Battalion Adjutant, compiled this history, which includes full listings of those who took part, and of the local branch of Cumann na mBan, the Women's Army. Originally privately published in the early 1970s, this new edition, the first for commercial sale, carries a foreword by his daughter and photo illustrations from the family collection.
